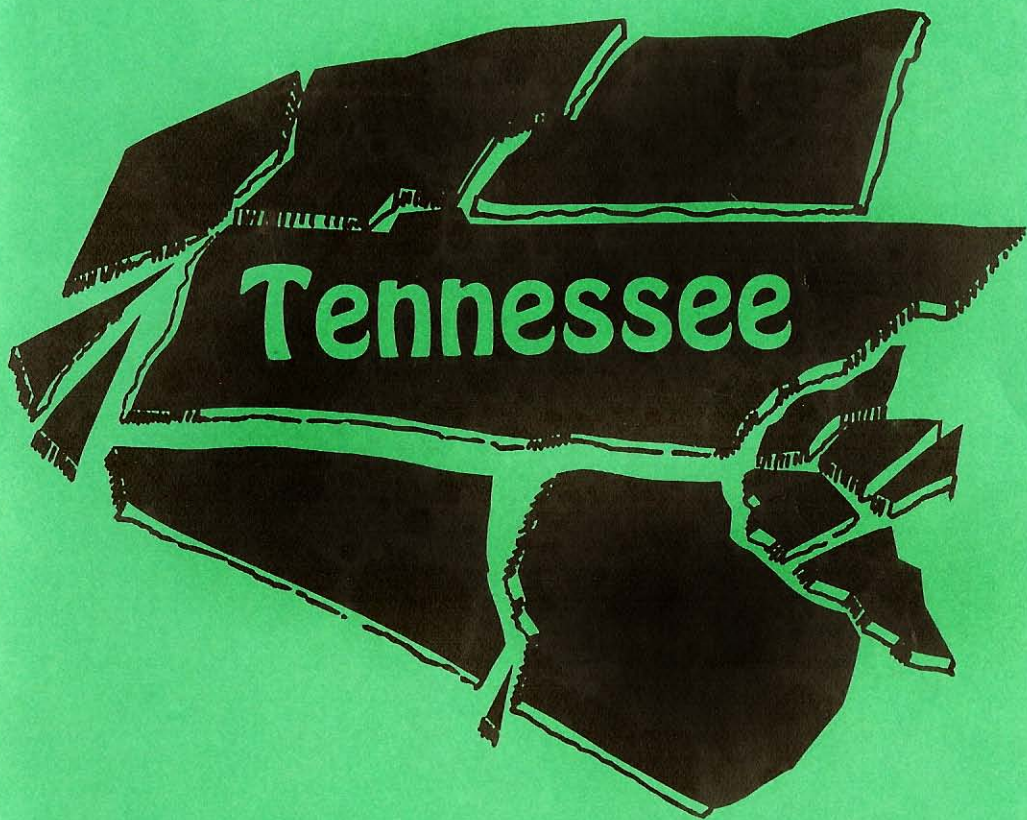

He regularly directs for the VPW and Waukesha Civic Theater, and directed the premier show for the Mainstreet Theater in Alma, Wisconsin. As an actor, Tom is an original member of Theatre Rx. He teaches adult acting technique for Joyce Parker Productions, and beginning children's drama for the Wauwatosa Recreation Department.

**Jeremy D. Schubot** (*Cardell*) is a seventh grader at Butler Middle School in Waukesha. In second grade, Jeremy played a guard in *Pegora The Witch* at the Sioux Falls, SD Community Playhouse.
